

Chad Hundeby, Honor Swimmer, United States of America, 1996

Chad Hundeby won 3 Majors: 1994 FINA Long Distance Swimming World Cup; 1993/1994 FINA Marathon Swimming World Series and 1991 25 km FINA World Championship. He set the speed record for the English Channel in 7 hours and 17 minutes in 1994 – which stood until 2005. He set the speed record for Catalina to the mainland in 8 hours and 15 minutes in 1993 – which stood until 1994 for females and 2009 for males. He set the speed record for the 30-32 km lac St. Jean in el in 7 hours and 17 minutes in 1994 – which stood until 2005.

He won professional marathon races in 1993: 30 km Fürth Marathon; 40.2 km Lac Memphrémagog and 40 km Lac St.-Jean; 36 km Atlantic City; and 25 km Swim across the Sound. In 1994 he won 36 km Riviera; 40.2 km Lac Memphrémagog; and 40 km Lac St.-Jean.

He is also an inductee in the International Swimming Hall of Fame (2012).
