Executive Committee: Responsibility/Role

The International Marathon Swimming Hall of Fame (IMSHOF) is managed by an [Executive Committee \(6 members in January 2025\)](#). Four are currently Honoree and two are no Honorees.

Please express interest to join the Executive Committee to info@IMSHOF.org. A first step is usually to volunteer to assist IMSHOF on a one of more smaller projects and gain experience.

The general responsibility/role is described as follows:

- a. Driving interest in the sport of marathon swimming and dedication to advance the IMSHOF
- b. Ability and willingness to put in monthly hours (reading, calls, small projects, etc.) to advance the goals of the IMSHOF
- c. Volunteer, take responsibility and deliver projects/areas of responsibility such as annual ceremonies, nominations/voting, website, Facebook, Instagram, YouTube, TikTok, finance, ISHOF liaisons, press announcements, creation of new materials, etc.
- d. Attend most of the annual ceremonies
- e. For new members – we value a fresh view: question, comment and suggest
- f. For new members – scan the website (so you understand the extent of the available material) and point out any errors, typos, non-standard approaches, etc.
- g. For new members – in the first year, read the short daily Facebook posts (or if you prefer 300+ biographies – maybe easier in the google drive than website). You are not expected to memorize or be an expert – but rather have an appreciation and vague memory which you can execute a search on. As an example – be aware of some Honoree activity down the Mississippi River and then be able to search biographies in the google drive to identify the three Honorees who are noted as accomplishing big swims.

Note - there are no paid stipends/expenses, so the Executive Committee members must fund their own travel.
