Trent Grimsey won 1 Major: 2012 FINA Grand Prix Series. That same year, Trent set the speed record for the English Channel in a time of 6 hours and 55 minutes - which stood until 2023. He set the speed record in Capri to Naples in 2012 in 6 hours and 29 minutes – which held until 2013.

At the 2009 Open Water Swimming World Championships in Italy, Trent placed 2nd in the 25 km. In 2012 he won 3 FINA Open Water Swimming Grand Prix races and placed 2nd in another. He was first Australian male to win a FINA Grand Prix Series.

Trent coaches in Grimsey's Adult Swimfit and (as of 2019) has inspired and coached 15 successful solo swimmers and numerous relay teams across the English Channel.
